

### Beginning to draw and color.

Five lessons that deal with controlling a pencil, glue, color crayons and oil pastels. Following directions and doing a comparison of media exercise are also addressed.

### Fall Drawing, Painting, & Sculpture

Six lessons that cover drawing, watercolor painting, cutting, gluing, and sculpting with clay. Student development in brush control, color choices, and use of art materials are all part of these six lessons.

### Winter Drawing & Creating

Seven lessons that include drawing, painting, cutting, and gluing. Development of creativity and an understanding of overlapping are two of the important points to come out of these seven lessons.

### Think Spring: Drawing, Painting, & Sculpture

Six lessons that cover drawing, tempera painting, cutting, gluing, and sculpting with clay. Student development in brush control, color choices, and use of art materials are all part of these six lessons.

# Level 2

#### **Mixed Media**

Four lessons about color choice and patterns.

#### Sculpture & Design

Three lessons that explore color and dimensional projects. Students learn to follow directions while still having the freedom to expand on the lesson.

#### **Drawing and Painting**

Eight lessons exploring drawing, design, creativity, and painting.

#### Spring Sculpture

Four lessons that explore creativity, dimensional images, and shapes. \*\*Clay will be used in two of these four projects. \*\*



# **Drawing & Painting**

Four lessons including drawing and painting with different media.

#### Sculpture, Painting, and Drawing

Four lessons touching on sculpture and the use of color.

### Design

Three lessons focus on design and layout of images.

### Painting & Design

Five lessons exploring design layout, media use, and application of that media.

# Level 4

#### Drawing, movement, shade, and depth

Five lessons that explore the study of how line creates movement and depth.

# **Exploring light**

Five lessons exploring light through different media.

#### Painting

Learning techniques of scale, watercolor, color choice, understanding of depth through drawing and color.

#### Exploring Overlapping

Three lessons focus on design and layout of images.



### Structure, Design, and Pattern

Four lessons focus on repetitive patterns using construction paper design, tempera paint, and craft sticks.

### Painting

Three lessons that explore an understanding of balance, density, use of area.

# Drawing

Three lessons that exercise creativity and the application of movement and color choices within a drawing.

### **Dimension and Design**

Two lessons that provide visual evidence of an understanding of dimension through a threedimensional project.

# Level 6

# **Dimension and Design**

Four lessons that allow the student to experience independent design and an understanding of visual illusion.

# Painting

Two lessons that provide visual evidence of an understanding of painting techniques.

#### **Drawing to Sculpture**

Three lessons focus on design and layout of images through drawing and sculpting.

#### Structure, Design and Pattern

Three lessons that explore an understanding of balance, pattern, and design.



# **Dimensional Drawing/Painting**

Four lessons to help the student identify all six sides of an object and know how to recognize them as a group, creating a three-dimensional image or as a part that stands alone.

### Sculpture

A lesson that applies knowledge of an understanding of design and dimension.

### Drawing

Three lessons focus on design and layout of images.

# Painting

Two lessons on the techniques of painting. Students create a design that can be painted.

# Level 8

### Drawing

Two lessons where students build on drawing techniques.

# Painting

Four lessons that allow the student to experience independent design and an understanding of different media.

#### Sculpture

Four lessons that explore creativity, dimensional images, and shapes through multiple types of media.



### Drawing

Three lessons on artistic techniques/control in graphite pencils, erasers, and blending stumps. Using drawing to enhance writing and building on our understanding of how different media can work together in one art piece.

#### Painting

Two lessons on the techniques of painting. Students create a design that can be painted.

#### Sculpture

Two lessons exploring structure. Students use applied knowledge to create facial structure and build a three-dimensional structure.

#### Other

A lesson on Cut Paper, identifying positive and negative space.
